Dear Councillor,

I wish to refer to the above and to the planning process that is now in train where by An Bord Pleanála are considering the planning application pursuant to Section 37E of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended. Having regard that the proposed development of an extension to the harbour, is designated as strategic infrastructure, the planning application is made directly to the Board as the adjudicating authority. In accordance with the legislation Galway City Council, being the planning authority for the area, is a prescribed body. The Planning Authority is obliged to prepare and submit to the Board a report setting out the views of the proposed development on the environment and the proper planning and sustainable development of the area of the authority. This report must be submitted within 10 weeks from the making of the application to the Board, the final date for submission in this case being the 2nd April 2014.

The Managers Report, before going to the Board, must be submitted to the Members of the Planning Authority and the views of the Members on the proposed development are sought. The Members may, by resolution, decide to attach recommendations specified in the resolution to the report of the authority. Where the Members so decide, the recommendations, together with the meeting administrators record shall be attached to the report being submitted to the Board.

As the Members are aware the planning preparation carried out prior to the lodgement of the application by the Harbour Company was extensive and meetings have been held with the City Council and An Bord Pleanála in respect to same. This also included a meeting held directly by An Bord Pleanála with Galway City Council.
