## HOUSING

The current crisis in housing is a direct result of the failure to build social housing-not one single social house has been built since 2009-resulting in 5,000 households, that is approximately 15,000 people on the waiting list-moreover the complete reliance on the private rental market through the Housing Assistance Payment (HAP) is intensifying the crisis

#### **HEALTH**

As a member of the Regional Health Forum since 2006, I have used my position to table questions/ motions at each meeting to improve the health service and to force change in relation to the scandalous waiting lists and the HSE West policy of renting buildings.

## **TRANSPORT**

I have consistently campaigned for an integrated public transport system built around a light rail and bus service together with park and ride facilities as the most sustainable solution to Galway's traffic congestion.

### **BUILDING COMMUNITIES**

Since 1999, I have worked with you on a range of projects including:

- Community Centres at Cappagh Park and Headford Rd: - ongoing campaign to ensure that they are kept in public ownership
- First rate recreational facilities at Westside including the retention of the running track and the basketball courts
- Working with residents and local area Councillors to improve residential areas
- · Designation of South Park as a 'Special Amenity Area'
- Master Plans for South Park and Kingston in progress
- Fisheries Watch Tower open to the public after 7 year battle
- Preservation of existing path in Merlin Woods for pedestrian/cycle use only and commitment to Master Plan
- Retention of the piers at Kilbeg and Knockferry in public ownership and the ongoing maintenance of these piers together with Lisloughrey, Oughterard and Woodquay
- Oral/written submission to Bord Pleanála hearing re sustainable extension for Galway Docks along with Rossaveel
- Commitment to new public Library Building instead of renting premises
- Sexual Assault Unit permanent building still awaited

### **POLICIES AND PRIORITIES**

I am committed to:

- Public Health Service with Public Nursing Home Beds and an improved ambulance service
- Implementation of the Primary Care Strategy
- Comprehensive services for people with special needs based on a rights-based agenda
- Public Housing Construction Program and development of housing co-operatives
- Integrated Public Transport System the provision of Light Rail with efficient Bus Services including a direct service across the Centenary Bridge along with Park and Ride facilities East/ West of the City and a broader school transport system
- Provision of clean water as a basic human right
- Support for small businesses as an integral part of our economy
- Balanced Development between the City and County of Galway
- An end to the use of our Airports and Airspace by foreign military forces
- Renewable Energy Projects as the key to our future development as per Paris-COP21
